

Minutes of Hoton Parish Council Extraordinary Meeting Held in Hoton Village Hall on Monday 11th October 2021 at 8pm

In attendance: Cllr Isbister (Vice-Chairman) (Chair), Cllr Eady, Cllr Doherty, Cllr Dargie and Victoria Webster (Parish Clerk)

The meeting commenced at 8.00 p.m.

Cllr Isbister welcomed the new Clerk to the Parish Council and the meeting.

1	<p>To receive apologies for absence Apologies were received from Cllr Cassell.</p>
2	<p>Declarations of interests: disclosable pecuniary interests; personal interests; or personal interests that may lead to bias, by parish councillors to items on the agenda. There were no declarations of interest.</p>
3	<p>To co-opt a councillor for Hoton Cllr Eady proposed to co-opt Simon Girgis as a Councillor, Cllr Isbister seconded the proposal. Simon Girgis to be appointed as a Hoton Parish Council Councillor.</p>
4	<p>Questions and comments from members of the public (10 minutes) No members of the public attended the meeting.</p>
5	<p>To agree any comments on the following planning applications</p> <p>a. P/21/1572/2 - Hoton Farm, Rempstone Road, Hoton, Leicestershire, LE12 5SF. Erection of an additional free range egg unit with associated feed bins, hardstanding's, access track and dirty water tanks.</p> <p>It was resolved to stay neutral on the application and submit comments seeking reassurance that all waste trucks are being covered on every occasion of clearance and that we would seek assurances that the paths will be maintained on a regular basis and we would prefer, according to local walker's experience that the paths are wider than the provided 2 metres. The comments will also include a reference to the Neighbourhood Plan that reflects on the rolling countryside hills around the village and that Hoton Farm are in fact interrupting these views.</p> <p>b. P/21/1480/2 - Hoton Farm, Rempstone Road, Hoton, Leicestershire, LE12 5SF. Two storey extension to side of agricultural dwelling to provide manager's office, meeting/staff rest room and additional living accommodation.</p> <p>It was resolved an objection is to be submitted for this application based on the grounds that there is no justification that the extension is required. The operation has been running without a house on site without anyone in situ since it opened and nothing has changed. There is insufficient evidence that this is needed.</p>
6	<p>To agree items for the press release The Parish Council has a new Clerk and her contact details are available on the website. The Co-option of a new Councillor, Simon Girgis.</p>
